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Rules and conditions for obtaining the certificate „Certified Professional for Lubricant Technology”

- Participation in all modules (according to confirmation of attendance)
 - Passed examinations of all separate modules 1 – 6 conducted at the end of the training days (at least 50% of possible points)
 - Passed final examination conducted at the end of the 2nd training week (at least 50% of possible points)
 - Printed training documents can be used for the examinations
 - At least 1 year professional experience in the field of lubricants
 - Prerequisite for admission to the final examination is the evidence of 1 year professional experience, granted by an employer statement on period of time for activities in the field of lubricants or alternatively by an employer’s reference that includes corresponding information
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Participants who passed the training and final exam for the qualification as “Certified Professional for Lubricant Technology (CPL)” are authorized to use the Logo, for example on their business cards, e-mails and any correspondence. Employers of persons qualified as Certified Professional for Lubricant Technology are authorized to point out the additional qualification of personnel.
